Washington, D.C. – The Special Operations Association of America is proud to be joined by 19 other Veteran organizations in support of Senators Moran and Blumenthal, and their recent [Senate Resolution](#) honoring the Veterans who have worked tirelessly to support and evacuate our Afghan allies since the fall of Kabul earlier this year.

Unable to abandon those they fought beside, these Veterans have sacrificed to hide, clothe, feed and shelter vulnerable Afghan allies, while coordinating with federal agencies on their behalf to evacuate them out of Afghanistan to safety. “The fall of Kabul resulted in a humanitarian crisis that our nation’s Veterans simply could not ignore,” stated Daniel Elkins, founder, and chief executive officer of the Special Operations Association of America. “We haven’t given up the fight for our Afghan allies, and are proud of the ceaseless efforts of our fellow Veterans who stand with us side-by-side in this fight.”
